

Our program for November is a presentation by Marc J. Dunkelman. Mr. Dunkelman is a Fellow for International and Public Affairs at the Watson Institute at Brown University, and the author of the book *The Vanishing Neighbor: The Transformation of American Community*. In his presentation, Mr. Dunkelman will discuss how many of the issues facing the US today can be traced to dramatic changes in the way American communities are organized, and especially to the loss of opportunities for neighbors from different walks of life to meet, get to know, and learn to trust each other. In particular, he credits civic organizations such as ours with playing an important "middle" role in bringing American communities together, with the decline of these organizations being linked to the current climate of polarization and distrust in our country. This is a presentation you won't want to miss.

This program is semi-public and I encourage you to bring your spouses and partners, who are also invited to join us for dinner at 6:30 and collation following the meeting. Please be sure to include your guest when you RSVP for dinner.
