At February's Stated Communication, *Brother Mike Ritz* shared the powerful and moving story of the extraordinary efforts by a group of former Marines to rescue Dr. Jalal -- a former Afghan translator with the 2/7 Marines who was marked for death by the Taliban -- and his family from Afghanistan after the American withdrawal in 2021.

After years of trying to secure the safety of Dr. Jalal and his family, these Marines were finally able to welcome the Jalals to their new home in Houston, Texas on January 31st. Each family member had with them only a single suitcase with which to rebuild their lives in America. The US government provided only a month's worth of financial support.

In recognition of Dr. Jalal's service to the United States and his sacrifice for the dream of a free Afghanistan, and in honor of the heroic efforts of the American servicemen who rescued him and his family, please consider donating as liberally as you can to the GoFundMe page that Bro.
